PARKING

Participant parking is not available at the finish venue. All designated parking is a short shuttle ride from the finish line (approximately 15 minutes). The address for the half marathon parking is **650 E Hospitality Ln. San Bernardino, CA 92408**.

Please utilize the Parking & Busing map to ensure easy access to parking and bus loading race morning. From approximately 8:00 AM to 10:00 AM there will be a continuous shuttle for participants to return to their cars from the finish area to the designated parking.

Spectators will be allowed to park in the area surrounding the finish venue. Street parking West (E San Bernardino Ave) and South (Dearborn St.) of the venue should be used.

BUSING

Marathon and half marathon participants will board buses in two separate locations within the parking area. All participants must take the bus and your bib is the ticket to board the bus. There is no parking at the start lines, and participants may not be dropped off at the start venues. Half marathon participants will board buses on the NE corner of the lot on Carnegie Drive and will depart from 3:15 a.m to 4:15 a.m.






AID STATION AMENITIES



Aid stations will be located approximately every two miles along the course. All aid stations will be supplied with Gatorade Endurance Lemon Lime electrolyte drink, water, restrooms, and basic first aid supplies. Additionally, various aid stations will be supplied with GU energy gels (GU Flavors will be chocolate, vanilla, and strawberry banana), fruit, doTERRA Deep Blue and medical personnel. The aid station map indicates the locations of each aid station as well as the supplies and amenities available.

DROP BAG

You will receive a race bag when you pick up your packet at the expo. This bag is for you to take to the starting areas. A number that matches your race bib will be attached to your race bag. This is to identify your bag at the finish area after the race, and you will need your bib to prove ownership of your bag when you pick it up. Please carry any belongings to the starting area in this bag, as opposed to any other personal bags, which cannot be identified by your race number. Bags must be placed in the bag trucks at the starting areas at least 15 minutes prior to the race start. Please do not leave keys, wallets or valuables in your drop bag.

EXPO

The REVEL Big Bear Expo will be held at the DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel San Bernardino on Friday, November 7, 2025, from 11:00AM - 6:00PM.

Free parking will be available at the expo, but is limited. If you are staying nearby, we highly recommend walking to the expo for the best possible experience.

SPECTATORS

Spectators will not be allowed on Highway 38 anywhere in the canyon during the race. Spectators are asked to select cheering points in the City of Mentone and City of Redlands only. Please note that there will be no parking allowed along the entire route.

Alternatively, spectators are invited to await the arrival of their runners at the finish venue on E. San Bernardino Ave (adjacent to Redlands Sports Park). Spectators may use street parking surrounding the venue but should not park at Redlands Sports Park

There will not be an awards ceremony for overall, team or age group winners. All awards can be picked up at the results tent.
