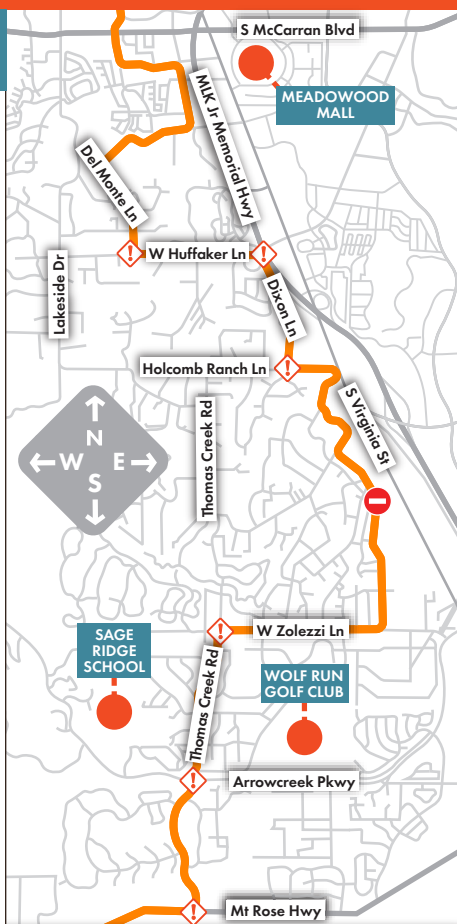
Sunday, May 17, 2026 6:00 AM-1:00 PM

This portion of the course passes through several key intersections; however, traffic patterns in this area will remain normal and largely unaffected. Roads will stay open, and no major delays are anticipated. The noted intersections will be intermittently held to allow runners to pass safely. Law enforcement personnel will be stationed to direct traffic

We encourage all drivers to remain attentive, follow standard traffic signage, and use caution when traveling near the course, as runners will be present along the route.

TRAFFIC ADVISORY:

From 6:00 AM–1:00 PM, motorists should expect delays at marked intersections along the course. While most roads will remain open and no detours will be in place, please note that a portion of S Virginia St will be closed between W Peckham Ln and Keitzke Ln. Other intersections noted will be intermittently held to allow runners to pass safely. Law enforcement personnel will be stationed to direct traffic.

The REVEL Reno Tahoe Marathon, Half, and 10K will be held on **Sunday, May 17** in Reno, Nevada. The race begins at the Mt Rose Trailhead and will finish at the Reno-Sparks Convention Center.

There will be adjusted traffic patterns and intersection delays along the course from 6:00 AM until 1:00 PM on Sunday, May 17.

The marked section of S Virginia St will be closed for the duration of the event, and motorists are advised to use caution as runners will be using a portion of the road along the rest of the route. Travelers in the area in the Tahoe and Reno areas should **plan ahead and prepare for extra travel time.**
